We've been busy...here's a quick list of things we've been working on:

*Ministerial search...we've been interviewing and are doing the reference checks. We hope to have some news soon.

*Bathroom leak is fixed...we had some problems with some leaks so that has been repaired and new shut off valves have been replaced

We'll distribute our video and training materials to the congregation in case you wanted to attend but couldn't. Board Meeting Notes March 15, 2022

To date \$46,527 has been received in pledges. It is expected that our budgeted goal will be reached. Total income to date is \$70,134.36 with expenses at \$41,211.20

\$1,330.35 was spent to make repairs in the men's restroom. A new furnace will be needed by next fall.

We will be signing up to participate in at least two Pride events in the coming months.

RE curricula for children and for teenagers need to be developed and in place by fall.
