There will be no worship services at the Alton church building in November. See below for the upcoming schedule.

Metro East Unitarian Universalist Congregation is the new name for our congregation, as approved by Congregational vote on Sunday, September 24, 2023.

Our new building is the Masonic Lodge in Glen Carbon, 90 Kriege Farm Road 62034.

At the **Zoom congregational meeting** held at 7:30 p.m. on November 1, 2023 there were 19 people present, plus 3 absentee ballots received, and a quorum was declared. The motion was made by Mary Johnson and seconded by Jessie Dominick that:

"The Metro East Unitarian Universalist Congregation (formerly known as the First Unitarian Church of Alton) lease the Edwardsville Masonic Lodge #99 from Nov. 2, 2023 to June 30, 2024." Following discussion of the motion it was approved unanimously.

We will be focused on making sure we have a smooth setup and breakdown for services, that all of our coffee hour routines are down pat, and that RE has everything it needs to help our children have a wonderful experience.

- g) Sunday, December 24: Short meditation at 10 a.m. in the new building, followed by a carpool caravan to carol at the nursing homes of our members. After caroling everyone is invited to come back for brunch at the Lodge.
- h) Sunday, December 31: New Year's Eve, NO SERVICE.

there's still a lot to do. Some items will be designated as going to storage and won't necessarily need to be boxed as a mover will take them to long term storage (e.g., folding chairs, tables, pulpit, and pulpit chairs, piano, desk(s), file cabinet(s) and some items downstairs. Other items need to be boxed as they will be taken to members' homes to await the move into the new place where they will be used when services begin again (e.g., hymnals, the chalice. other pulpit décor. membership books, paper products, etc.) Other items, especially downstairs are destined to be given away (check them out, you might want some of them), or hauled away by a trash mover.

Available for your taking include a desk or two, file cabinets, miscellaneous chairs, card tables, etc. A date can be scheduled for you to pick up any of the desired items for which you might need something besides your car to take them home in.
